A Note From Bryan...

Example and Influence

Example and Influence... cannot be overstated. Volumes have been written for generations about the power influence and the need for great examples. For the Christian, Jesus Christ is our primary example. After that, we have many good brethren who serve as role models for us as we seek to be more like Christ and allow His word to influence our lives. The hope is that others will follow our example of living for Jesus.

This Sunday I have chosen to try something a little different by preaching both of the day's lessons out of one passage. When we think of the example and influence of Christ in our lives, the portion of His early ministry where He was tempted by Satan (Luke 4:1-13) certainly comes to mind, since we face temptation every day of our lives. Temptation is everywhere, and it always will be.

In the morning's lesson, we will look at how Jesus serves as an example from Luke 4:1-11. In these verses, Jesus showed us how to be prepared for life and all it has to throw at us. Consider what you have endured this week. Whatever you felt unprepared for, your experience this week will shape how you handle similar experiences for the rest of your life. Jesus was an example of several other things we'll examine, as well.

In the evening's lesson, we will look at how Jesus overcame temptation. Overcoming temptation is a much different idea than avoiding temptation. At least one popular religion today teaches that temptation must be avoided. In His ordeal in the desert, Jesus showed us how to overcome rather than just avoid. While there may be certain things or certain ways you can avoid, overcoming temptation is a far superior idea to practice in your everyday life. My aim this week is to give you the spiritual nourishment and encouragement you need to carry on another week.
