I'm so Proud of You Zackie

Last Sunday evening after services when Zack Kay was baptized into Christ we were all very proud of him and the commitment he had made to follow Christ for the rest of his life! All of us were feeling that emotion, but one 4-year old young lady, Kalyn Jones, the daughter of Kelsey Jones and great-granddaughter of Brenda Queen, in one of the most tender of moments, unable to delay herself any longer, ran up to Zack, threw her arms wide open, embraced his knees (about tackling him) and clutched them and said for all to hear in that voice that only a four year old girl can make "I'm so proud of you Zackie"!
