From time to time it is good to provide an update for our readers (& contributors) with facts concerning our work in India. This article will attempt to deal with that kind of information in greater detail. GOSPEL MEETINGS—these are one-day affairs, with 1 to 6 speakers (4 to 6 speakers would be for all-day gatherings). Last year, our team conducted a record number of meetings for our work in India—492,000. When we have the funds do to the meetings, the Lord will give the increase. The Lord helped us to lead 954,000 souls to Christ and His church. Our team is comprised of more than 25,000 Indian preachers, who come from various backgrounds. Those who are local preachers in villages often are not well-versed in terms of formal education—but they have a deep & abiding faith in the one true God & the Bible as His Word. While many of these men are not great orators, they use their opportunities to set up Gospel meetings from the contacts they make. In turn, these local men invite more experienced preachers to preach in the Gospel meetings that they arrange—often with entire denominational congregations. Our brethren tell them about the Lord's church—its identity, worship, basis for beliefs, etc. They also tell them how to become Christians according to the New Testament. Our Indian brethren are extremely evangelistic. They are constantly talking to others about the Lord & His church. A key ingredient for this effort is in discussing the Bible with friends & neighbors, including denominational church members & preachers. Such discussions lead to group Bible studies—and then, often to Bible studies & Gospel meetings with those denominational folks. If we can lead the preacher to the Truth, then we have a very good chance of converting his entire congregation to the Lord's way. The success of this work is due to the grace of God & His powerful Gospel. In human terms, it is due to the hard work of our Indian brethren. They are doing—and must do—the bulk of this work. This must be an Indian work to succeed in the long run. And that is exactly what is happening in our work in India right now.

When Gospel meetings are conducted among interested people, God's Word is planted in good & honest hearts. And the result is that folks obey the Lord—and local churches are planted. Those who become Christians (& form these new congregations) continue to be taught by the local preachers who started the entire process. And this is repeated over and over. Starting a new church in India is not as complicated as it is in the USA. You want to start a congregation? Begin having worship services in your home. When a congregation (esp. in large cities) has filled up all their available space, one of their members will have a Gospel meeting in his home with the view of starting a new congregation. It becomes a "Cornelius meeting"—friends & neighbors come. This is followed by other meetings & studies. When some obey the Gospel, a new church of Christ is planted. When denominational preachers obey the Gospel, it often leads to their congregations becoming churches of the Lord. Most preachers work with 2 or 3 churches—with time & teaching, each of these will become a congregation of God's people. As our brethren continue to tell others about the Lord's church, more & more such Gospel meetings are arranged, those with good & honest hearts obey God, & more churches are planted.
