Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

"SUCH A TIME AS THIS"

Esther's presence in the Persian Empire was likely more than coincidence. God may have placed her there through His providence, for "such a time as this." God's people were being threatened with destruction. Haman had coerced the king to issue a decree that all Jews would be killed on a certain day. Esther's presence, however, upset Haman's plot and he, consequently, was hung on his own gallows!

As the Jews were in trouble then, it is obvious that our nation and Christianity today is similarly in trouble. God has been deserted, sin is magnified and practiced to a sickening degree, homosexuality, the sin that caused Sodom's destruction, is unashamedly promoted. Murders are committed daily in our cities. The home, as God ordained it, is in sharp decline as people decide to live together in fornication rather than to obey God. Parents are killing their children and children are killing their parents, and sin is being glorified by the media and Hollywood. How long will God permit it to continue?

In the church we see much the same trend. The Gospel is not preached in many churches; comparatively few are telling their friends and neighbors about the Lord so they can be saved; sin dressed in immodest apparel is overlooked and tolerated as more of the body is uncovered than covered at any given time; imbibing of alcohol and drugs while encouraging others, even the little ones to sin in so doing; church discipline is not practiced; doctrine is watered down until unrecognizable and ineffective; worship is corrupted in many places by adding the musical instrument and female leadership roles; there is compromise on every hand; too many are the congregations who have an agenda to be like the denominations around us instead of holding to the truth of one church (Ephesians 4:4).

What is going to be the outcome in our nation and church? Will we stand or fall? Will we do the first works and see the blessing of God through salvation? Or will we continue to dabble in sin and lethargy and watch our churches decline and our souls vanish away?

Who will lead this nation back to God (II Chronicles 7:14)? Who will lead the church to forsake the path it is on and return to God's Word and teach it and live by it? Who will lead their homes in the same direction? Could it be you? "Who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"
