Malachi, a messenger from God, fiercely condemned divorce. (Malachi 2:16). In verse 13, we note these words; "And this again you do; you cover the altar of Jehovah with tears, with weeping, and with sighing, inasmuch that He does not regard your offering any more, neither receives it with good will at your hands."

So the people asked the question in Verse 14, "Why not?" Why will God no longer honor and accept our offerings? Malachi replies: "Because Jehovah has been witness between you and the wife of your youth, against whom you have dealt treacherously, though she is your companion, and the wife of your covenant."

When a man and woman marry, (with God's approval), they become partners for life, and for life are viewed as co-partners with God Himself, the third member of the union, and "a witness between you and the wife of your youth" (Genesis 31:50).

So, when the marriage covenant between man and woman is broken, it is also broken with God. When one "deals treacherously" (divorces) with the wife of his youth, who has been his companion throughout life, he is automatically sinning against God and every holy obligation connected with true religion. As with the rejection by God of the sacrifices offered by those to whom Malachi referred, the same is true of such men today; their worship offerings are similarly rejected because they in divorcing the wife of their youth have broken the covenant with her and with God! Forever be gone the idea that "the sin is not in the divorce, but only in the subsequent unscriptural remarriage!" The fact of our current godless culture's tolerance and approval of divorce and remarriage is a sinful blight upon our society, and in too many instances today, even in the church! Man does not have the right to allow what God hates and what He has forbidden. Marriage is not simply a social institution; rather it is a divine ordinance with the Lord himself being the chief witness at the wedding ceremony."

In verse 16, "For I hate putting away, says the Lord, the God of Israel, and him who covers his garment with violence, says the Lord of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that you deal not treacherously."

Yet, it has been said by some today that "divorce is not that bad! I'll file for divorce even if God hates it and after the divorce is granted, I'll just "repent", be forgiven, and marry another one, other than the one I'm putting away!"

PROBLEM: Matthew 19:9! If the separation was not "for the cause of fornication" (Matthew 5:32), one will not only sin in the divorce, but will become an adulterer when he "marries" the second one, and the one he marries will become an adulteress, and neither of the two will enter the kingdom of God (I Corinthians 6:9-10). As well, the only way to repent of this adulterous relationship, is to cease living with the second spouse in adultery. True repentance emanates from true godly sorrow followed by full restoration that includes giving up what doesn't belong to you!

God hates divorce! That means every time it happens, sin is involved! Our society, estranged from God, loves divorce. The shameful acceptance of the violation of the marriage covenant on the part of many today is a cruel, heartless, and brutal fact of our culture. We are rapidly, as a nation, and a church (with carefree leadership) drifting into a state of godlessness from which there might never be a general return!

BOTTOM LINE: With whomever you make a covenant, KEEP IT, LIKE IT OR NOT!
