A Note From Bryan. . . Examine Your Spiritual Condition

When a child fails to grow physically as he or she ought to, parents get alarmed and do everything within their power to find out why. As a matter of fact, if your child was not progressing mentally or physically, you would probably go beyond your means to find answers and solutions. Physical and mental growth is marked by periods of growth that are easily recognizable. What about spiritual growth?

The thing about spiritual growth is that it is not as visible or obvious as mental or physical growth. Mature Christians recognize growth when they see it but there is no objective set of standards; no set that we all agree upon and look to as a means of measuring one another. I cannot measure your spiritual growth and you cannot measure my spiritual growth. Because it is not obvious it is easy to overlook too.

Sometimes factors beyond control inhibit mental and physical growth. There are things that happen to people that cannot be changed with diet and exercise. For people who are mentally and physically healthy, diet and exercise, along with adequate mental challenge, help growth and development. This is not the case for those who have deficiencies that cause grief and stress for parents. Do parents get as concerned when their children don't seem to grow spiritually?

Beyond parenting, spiritual growth is up to the individual. How you grow and what you do to grow spiritually is largely up to you, once you reach the age of accountability. When boys are young, they are concerned with their appearance and they will do almost anything to grow taller. Are our young men as concerned about their relationship with God? According to Scripture (Hebrews 5:14), spiritual maturity is defined as having our senses exercised to know good and evil.

The author of Hebrews wrote this to a group of Christians who had grown dull spiritually, their spiritual lives were reverting back to their former way of life. Our spiritual life has to be something that we examine and exercise; it is something that we have to care for in order to grow and develop properly. As you consider your life and the progress you are making your spirituality has to be a part of that equation. How would God measure you? As we consider the words of Hebrews 5:11-14, ask yourself the vital question of how concerned you are about growing in your relationship with God.
