### A Note From Bryan... Fathers: The Good, The Bad, and The Ugly

It's that time of year again when we give honor to a parent. This time, it's honor for Dad. The place of a father in the life of a child is of immeasurable importance. For those of us who were fortunate enough to grow up with a loving and caring father at home, we are thankful to our Dads for teaching us so many useful things and giving us the discipline we needed.

Sadly, not everyone grows up with a supportive father in the home. The rate of absenteeism is appalling. As a reaction to absentee and abusive fathers, the most radical wing of the feminist movement came out several years ago with statements to the effect that children are better raised in institutions than in homes with fathers. This statement I give you secondarily from James Dobson's book, *Bringing Up Boys*. It is sad that people feel that way, but it may be because we, as fathers, have not gone far enough in our leadership of the home.

In the Bible, the word father appears numerous times; literally thousands of times. Many of those references speak of God the Father. The overwhelming majority of occurrences are in reference to ancestral roots. There is surprisingly little direct instruction to fathers. A handful of Proverbs, Ephesians 6:4 and a few verses in 1 John are just about all the direct instruction to be found. However, the Bible contains numerous examples of fathers. We learn best by example and God knew that. The examples of fatherhood from Scripture demonstrate the keys to being what God wants as fathers. The Bible also contains many examples of what not to do as a father. Today we will look at a few of these examples; good, bad, and just plain ugly, and, in true Clint Eastwood style, I hope it "makes your day!"
