India Missions

India is a land of beauty and enchantment. It is the home of the Taj Mahal, the Golden Temple of Amritsar, Golconda Fort which once stored the Hope Diamond, and Hyderabad, the City of Pearls.

India is a land of diversity. From the Himalayan Mountains, to the desert areas of the west, to the beaches of Goa, to the Bay of Bengal, India's geography is spectacular. In India you can find things which are exotic in nature – tigers, elephants, camels, a monopoly of the world's most venomous snakes, and Assam Pobitora National Park (the rhinoceros capital of the world). You also find the mundane – chickens, pigs, cats, dogs, and, of course, cows, which Gandhi called "the mother(s) to millions of Indian mankind".

In India, great wealth and great poverty coexist side by side.

India is a land of ethnicity. A multitude of ethnic groups speaking over 1600 different languages inhabit a land area 1/3 the size of the United States – 1.3 billion people to be exact.

We see India as a land of opportunity. We see 1.3 billion souls, who, just like any others, need the gospel. Our work in India offers many opportunities to share and spread the Gospel. Opportunities are found from lantern-lit villages to techno super cities. We have opportunities to convert people from denominational churches, Hinduism, and occasionally from Islam. We have more opportunities than we can keep up with.

The Woodstock Church of Christ has taken a great role in this work. We were blessed to have Dave and Matt Amos, Reg and Kathy Berry, and Gary Yoder with us this past January. It was great to travel and work with them in Hyderabad, Bidar, Markapur, Pamidipadu and Chirala. It was great to show them the ongoing work in these areas, hear them teach and tell stories, and just to visit. Having fresh faces in India is a real treat for all of us. We are thankful for Woodstock, your interest in mission work, and your love for the lost. We would like to have many and more of you come to see and share our work in India firsthand.
