Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

CALLING ON THE NAME OF THE LORD

In the religious world today many have come to propose that "calling on the name of the Lord" is simply to recite a programmed "sinner's prayer", the result of which is one's remission of sins and salvation. Our subject phrase is seen in Romans 10:13; "For whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved." As well, the same phrase is seen in the prophecy of Joel (2:32) and its fulfillment in the second chapter of the book of Acts (Verse 21). But what does the phrase mean? In order to determine the scriptural meaning one may not, with sound hermeneutics, pronounce an absolute meaning that does not consider the context in which the phrase is found. Without doing so, one cannot rightly divide the word of truth (II Timothy 2:15). Let's then consider the context of Acts, chapter two. First of all, those who were seeking the salvation that was granted to them that day were not told to recite a "sinner's prayer".

In Verse 21, Peter quoted Joel's prophecy showing that if his hearers would be saved they must "call on the name of the Lord". It is evident that three thousand souls were saved that day and added to the Lord's church. If they were saved (and they were, Acts 2:47), then it must be the case that they had "called on the name of the Lord", otherwise salvation could not have been granted! Clearly, the answer to the question "what does 'calling on His name' mean" is determined by knowing what the three thousand did to be saved. They were told to repent and be baptized (Acts 2:38), which they did (Acts 2:41), resulting in their salvation (Acts 2:47). Therefore, 'calling on His name' may scripturally and contextually be defined as coming to Him in trust and obedience, both of which encompass saving faith.

The same logic is seen in Acts 22:16 where Saul was told, "And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord." Saul clearly did the same thing as did the three thousand on Pentecost. The phrase in this verse shows how the action of the verb "be baptized" is to be accomplished and defined, i.e., "Calling on the name of the Lord".
