An understanding of what Malachi taught in chapter three ought to force many Christians to their knees in repentance. If God considered the non-payment of tithes, or just a partial payment of them as "robbing God," what about professed Christians who do not give as much to the work of God as they spend for ball games, movies, soft drinks and tobacco? Any honest study and evaluation of what men are doing today must reach the conclusion that many have certainly not stopped robbing God!

Clearly, the whole concept of stewardship should abolish the mindset that says, "Based on Malachi 3:8, ten percent of what I have been given by God is to be given back to Him on Sunday morning, but the remaining ninety percent is all mine." Well, that concept and the Old Testament Law was taken out of the way, having been nailed to the cross (Colossians 2:14)! All of what we own belongs to God!

It's true that no specific commandment to tithe is to be found in the New Testament as in the Old Testament and, therefore, the tithe does not apply in the church. However, we are commanded to give "freely," and to give "liberally," and to give "as God has prospered us". Therefore, how could one claim that giving less than a tenth can, by any stretch of the imagination, be classified as giving freely and liberally as God has prospered us? Impossible and reckless, to say the least! The selfishness of those folks claiming redemption under the Law of Christ, as demonstrated by what they give, must be laid alongside the example of those ancient Jews, and must be classified by the same words of Malachi. It is robbing God!

In verse nine of this chapter, Malachi pronounced the will of God toward those who failed to give as He had directed, saying "Ye are cursed with the curse; for ye rob me, even this whole nation." That curse was separation from God because the priests and the people withheld what was due God and lavished it on themselves. If they were separated from God (Isaiah 59:1-2) because they robbed God, can we expect separation from Him by sinning in the withholding of that which is due Him under the Law of Christ?

We are to support the proclamation of the Gospel throughout the world (Matthew 28:19-20; 1 Corinthians 9:1-14; Galatians 6:6; 1 Timothy 5:17-18). We are to give to the poor, especially the saints (Acts 6:1-6; Romans 12:13; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2; 2 Corinthians 8 & 9; Gal. 2:10; 6:10; etc.). From 2 Corinthians 8 & 9 and Philippians 4 as well, we certainly see that our giving should be out of gratitude, and something we joyfully do, not of necessity, but motivated by love for Him and the souls of men!

Better to sacrifice, even robbing self of two mites, rather than robbing God!
