A Note From Bryan... Happy Father's Day

According to Wikipedia, Father's Day is celebrated by 52 countries of the world at different times during the year. It was first proposed as a national holiday in the early twentieth century and was met with a great deal of resistance. The idea of a national holiday complimenting Mother's Day by honoring the male parental role was laughable to many in those early days. Opponents considered Father's Day the "slippery slope" toward too many meaningless holidays. This is a sad thought when you consider what Father's contribute to the family unit. It is also surprising that even in the late Victorian period attitudes toward fatherhood were similar to those of today.

There are some among our population and hopefully it is a small percentage, who believe that Fathers are unnecessary. Personally, I can't imagine what my children's life would be like without me in their lives. I know that God will make a way, but I feel my contribution is necessary, and so should you. It might be interesting to find out how many prisoners are there today because they did not have a strong male role model at home teaching them to do honest work and instilling core values within those boys and girls. Yes, many of those incarcerated may have known their fathers and even had them in the home. It might be further revealed that the father in the home was distant, irresponsible, or the wrong example.

The indifferent attitude toward fatherhood has perpetuated itself in many negative ways and there are now efforts right here in our city that are attempting to deal with the problem in different communities. Rather than lay the burden of teaching self-esteem, morals, and values upon the public school system that fails to recognize an all-powerful, creator God, righteous Fathers need to step in and fill that role together with a godly Mother. Space does not allow me a full treatment of this subject and how seriously we must take our roles as Fathers. May God richly bless your efforts to be a good Father to your children and provide the spiritual leadership of your family.
