A Note From Bryan...

Guilty conscience?

Do you ever suffer from a guilty conscience? Chances are you do from time to time. I won't ask you to reveal too much about what makes this happen in your life and I certainly don't mean to put you on the spot. It is just a question for thought because as human beings we all suffer from this malady occasionally. Things don't always go as planned. Our words do not always come out as we intend them to sound. We make mistakes. For those who are conscientious, guilt begins to get the best of us and we wish for another opportunity to undo those mistakes and misspoken and misunderstood words.

In Matthew 14 we read of a very costly mistake in the life of Herod the Tetrarch of Galilee. The kinds of things that trigger our guilty conscience are trivial by comparison to what was bothering Herod. First of all Herod had married his brother's estranged wife, which was contrary to the Law of Moses. John the Baptist told Herod it was wrong, and Herod and Herodias, Herod's unlawful wife was angry at John so they had him arrested and imprisoned. You are probably familiar with how the story ended in John being beheaded at Herodias' daughter's birthday party. As the fourteenth chapter begins Herod hears of Jesus' message and His miracles, and he was convinced that John the Baptist had risen from the dead.

What is informative about this passage is the lengths Herod and Herodias had to go to in order to further the lie they were living. They used force and intimidation to keep John quiet and they tried to keep him locked away. They were both willing to murder and involve a child in their continuing downward spiral of violence. The message for us is that the Bible speaks to us about the importance of guarding our conscience and keeping it clean. I hope this lesson will help you in your day to day living and help you find healthy ways to deal with your nagging guilty conscience.
