In this life all roads lead to a rendezvous with death and a final destiny which is based on what we do on life's road. The choices and decisions we make on that road will lead ultimately to a unique legacy. It's non-negotiable: you will leave a legacy. The question is not whether you'll leave a legacy but what legacy you will leave or "what will you leave behind?"

The means by which you move through your life provide the platform that supports your vision in life. Courtesy, honesty, respect, Christian fellowship, and adherence to God's Word: These are the qualities that make for a desirable legacy. The way you live your life, your work in the kingdom, the dear one's in your family and those you have met along the way that you have taught the way of salvation; all will have an effect on how you are remembered.

Thinking of your legacy is like starting anything new. The picture may be a bit foggy at first, but stick with it as you study and focus on His Word. Clarity will come, and when the picture is in focus, you will be able to establish goals; goals that will determine "what you will leave behind".

Once focused: stay focused, because brevity of life will not permit continual dallying with suggested options. Your goals must be clear, responsibilities fulfilled, intentions and actions honorable. You must decide: If not this way, there is no other way (John 14:6; Acts 5:29).

You can ignore the questions for quite some time. Why am I here? What will I leave behind? But, eventually these questions will demand answers from you. To come to the point where you think seriously about your legacy, you must first reach a level of reality, maturity, and commitment to God's Word that will affect your eternity to follow.

The wonderful part of considering your legacy is the clarity it brings to daily decisions. Each decision moves you closer to or further from your legacy. Your planned legacy will help you to know how to live in the present in order to be remembered well when you are gone.

Make this life of yours into a picture of which Christ would approve now and in the judgment to come. Your planned legacy when realized, then, will be a self-portrait of who you really are. It will be summed up in a few words. So let the words of those left behind be words of goodness and truth (Revelation 2:10). Remember, folks are going to talk about you when you are gone. What will they say?

We only live once, but once is enough if we do it right. So what legacy and destiny awaits you? When you take your final bow, who will you be? How will you enter eternity? Will you be just a footnote in history? Will your posterity follow your life's example and strive for the same legacy? Will your children really be able to say, "I want my legacy to be just like what Mom's and Dad's was." Live to answer and honor these questions, because when it comes to your legacy and what you leave behind, it will really count! What you leave behind will play a large part in determining your final destination (Matthew 6:19-21).
