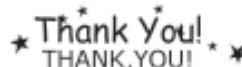

A Note From Bryan. . . The Ways and Thoughts of God

Isaiah 55:8, 9 states,

"For My thoughts are not your thoughts,
Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord.
"For as the heavens are higher than the earth,
So are My ways higher than your ways,
And My thoughts than your thoughts." NKJV

This is one of those passages of Scripture that has wide application in our lives. It is one that typically comes to mind easily to explain things we can't always explain. They are words that intrigue and they can be words that comfort. In studying these words a little closer they let us all know with certainty that while we may not know all the ways of God or all of His mind He has revealed to us all that we need to know.

- Deuteronomy 29:29 "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."
- 2 Peter 1:3 "as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness"

Today we will spend both services, both lesson times, looking at the Isaiah passage in order to come to know at least a few of God's thoughts and God's ways. We will begin with God's thoughts and what clearly stood out to me in this study is how much the word reveals to us what God's thoughts were from the beginning. God's mind in revealed in His word and it was revealed so that we would know how to imitate God's thoughts and ways in our lives on this earth. It is certain that more could be said about God's thoughts and ways. This study is not an attempt to be comprehensive but to get our minds and lives going in the right direction.
