A Note From Bryan...

Conquering fear...

What is it that strikes fear in your heart? You may not want to reveal it because it makes you feel too weak or vulnerable, but everyone is afraid of something. You may be afraid of having to give a speech or a public presentation of some kind. Many people are terribly afraid of speaking in public. The things that scare you may be much deeper than this. It is common for people to be afraid of being left alone. Death is also a universal fear among people.

Christians have some fears that are even deeper and more significant. Christians are afraid of what might happen after death, more than death itself. It is many a Christian that is unprepared for, and fearful of, a harsh verdict on the Day of Judgment. I find that Christians are afraid of making irrevocable mistakes in sharing the gospel. Christians are often afraid of offending a friend with the truth and, thereby losing the friendship. You may fear an emotional reaction from a neighbor, so you don't talk to them about their soul. I apologize if you think I paint with too broad a brush, but we are all afraid of something spiritually significant.

Today we are going to look at overcoming our fears using Jesus words to His disciples in Matthew 14:22-33. From this passage come three great fears, and Jesus spoke words of comfort and encouragement in each instance. Jesus addressed the fear of being alone, the fear of the unknown, and the fear of trying something you have never tried before. What really stands out from this passage is the disappointment expressed by Jesus because of doubts caused by our fears. I hope you will find Christ's words to be a source of strength and encouragement as you seek to overcome your fears and develop a stronger, deeper faith.
