A Note from the Elders... Are Troublesome Times Here?

(I Thessalonians 4:16 - 18)

The chorus of one of my favorite hymns starts, "Jesus is Coming Soon." Perhaps in each of our lives, we can reflect on seasons of trouble and concern. Congregations of Believers around the world are facing extra pressure from things like tornados, flooding, fires, etc. Many people have lost not only possessions, but also loved ones. Over the past few years, we at Woodstock can look back on how God gives strength to those individuals facing "Troublesome Times" -- loss of job, failing health, CANCER and those serving our country away from home.

Ralph Waldo Emerson said, "A man is what he thinks about all day long." Marcus Aurelius said, "A man's life is what his thoughts make it." Norman Vincent Peal said, "Change your thoughts and you change your world." The Bible says, "for as a man thinketh in his heart, so is he." (Proverbs 23:7)

In "Troublesome Times," I have found great peace in reading Psalms 23. Most of us know it by heart. The 118 words it contains have POWER! The power of this Psalm lies in the fact that it represents a positive, hopeful, faith approach to life. David expresses the same spirit that Paul wrote of in Philippians 3:13-14, "forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press on toward the mark."
