I'M COMMITTED!
July 3, 2016

Either you are committed or you are not! Either you are moving forward, standing still, or going backwards! There's no halfway! We all face moments of decision that can change the rest of our lives and our walk with Him. As members of the Church, we must ask ourselves, "Will I dive in and get involved or just stand at the edge and look on? Will I step forward or will I merely test the temperature of the water?"

Some sins are committed because we choose to do wrong; other sins are committed because we choose to do nothing, even other sins are committed because we don't know that there must be a choice (ignorance). Being only sort of committed to the gospel can lead to frustration, unhappiness, and guilt. This should not apply to us because we are a covenant people. We made a covenant with the Lord when we were baptized. Nothing can be more important than keeping a commitment we have made to the Lord. Remember the reply of Rachel and Leah to Jacob in the Old Testament. It was simple and straightforward and showed their commitment: "Whatever God has said unto you, do" (Genesis 31:16).

Those who are only sort of committed may expect to only sort of receive His blessings. The windows of heaven might only be sort of open to them. Wouldn't it be foolish to think, "I'll commit myself maybe 50 percent now, but somehow when Christ appears at the Second Coming, He'll see as me as have been committed 100 percent"?

Commitment to our covenant with the Lord is a fruit of our conversion. Remember the fruits of the Spirit? "Total Commitment" to our Savior and His church will build our character and strengthen our spirit to glorify His name and will prepare us to meet Him. Having done so, when we stand before Him, He'll then keep His commitment to us and we will hear Him say, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21). To those claiming commitment, but with no or little involvement and personally demonstrated action will hear as did the one talent man, "You wicked and slothful servant" (Matthew 25:26), cast the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Matthew 25:30).

Obviously, there is a difference between intention and action. Those who only intend some day to commit will find excuses at every turn. Those who are truly committed will face their challenges squarely and say to themselves, "Yes, that might appear to be a reason to delay, but I have made a covenant with my Lord, and so I will do my best to glorify His name by doing what I have committed to Him to do."

In some way, each of us stand at a decision point overlooking the water deciding to dive in or not! It is my prayer that each one of us will have faith, move forward, face all fears and doubts with courage, and say to ourselves, "I'm committed! I'm going in!"
