A Note From Bryan...

Jesus wept

Have you ever had a time when you just lost it? When you just couldn't control yourself anymore? I suppose we have all, even the strongest among us, lost our temper or burst into tears when we got to a point where we just couldn't contain it anymore. Sometimes it just seems like the world folds in on you all at once. It should make us feel a little better to know that Jesus had a few of those moments too.

In Luke 19:41, Jesus was overcome by grief when He looked out over Jerusalem knowing that it would someday be destroyed because of unrighteousness and that thousands would suffer. More than that, Jesus wept over the city because it was so unnecessary and avoidable. Luke then tells us that Jesus took that sadness and turned it into righteous indignation that cleansed the temple of those who turned it into an emporium.

We find another of these powerful emotions exhibited by Jesus in John 11:35. This is often touted as "the shortest verse in the Bible." But in its context it stands out so prominently. The most obvious reason that Jesus wept was over the loss of His friend. Most of us have been at that same place; standing beside the grave of a dearly departed loved one, overwhelmed by the loss, and contemplating our own departure. As morbid and depressing as it may sound, this story has a happy ending. In our lesson this morning, we will look at some of the not so obvious aspects of why Jesus wept.
