A Note from an Elder . . . Negative Thinking

Can you imagine a world where there was no negativity? I don't mean a world without legitimate sadness or anger. I am talking about a world in which there were no put-downs, no belittling of self or others, no sarcastic remarks, no hostility, no power-tripping, no insults, no bigotry or intolerance.

That's a pretty tall order, isn't it - even to imagine such a place? So let's back it up a little and try another question. Can you imagine your own life without any negativity? Maybe that's a pretty tall order, too. So how about this - what would it be like to go through a full day and night without any negativity?

I'm talking about a 24-hour period during which you stop yourself from engaging in any negative thinking or negative behavior whatsoever. No put-downs, no sarcasm, no teasing or belittling of others or yourself.

This is an exercise I have asked people to try before. You should have heard the groans when I gave this task to a group. However, the results are usually very powerful. First, they became aware of the amount of negative thinking they routinely do. Then, they realized that negative thinking is something they can bring under control, with a little practice. Then finally, they experienced how good it feels when they stop the negativity.

Give it a try - it is worth the effort.
