A Note From Bryan... Previews

This morning's bulletin article will be a little lighter on content than usual because I will try to give you a preview of both of today's lessons. This morning we will be looking into Matthew 15:1-20. This is a passage where Jesus openly pointed out the contradictions between the traditions upheld by the Scribes and Pharisees and the direct commands of God. We are going to look deeper than the differences between tradition and doctrine because Jesus gives an evaluation of the Scribes and Pharisees that should inform our daily walk.

The Jewish hierarchy didn't have an accurate picture of themselves and the value they brought to their world. Besides making a statement of the importance of having a clear picture of what is tradition and what is doctrine, this passage teaches us the importance of having an accurate picture of ourselves. The hope is for us to take an honest look at ourselves in order to see what God sees when He looks at us.

Beyond this article you will find the title of tonight's lesson. I point it out because I don't want you to miss it. We often take certain things for granted. We all want to create a church that is attractive to others and we want to be a part of a growing, thriving church that makes a difference in the world, or, at least, in our community. We want a place we feel confident to bring our friends into. There are those times when we move to a new area and begin to look for a new church home and make our choices based upon which congregation offers the best situation for our families.

Have we taken for granted that the method we use to shop for a church is correct because it is what happens and because it is what we do? Have we considered that the way we shop for a church has been influenced by things other than biblical principles? Do we consider that just maybe the way we shop for a church has been influenced by a secular worldview, a booming marketplace, or the offerings of the larger religious community around us. Do we feel that as a church we must compete for numbers by offering the latest and greatest programs? These are a few of the questions I hope to answer or at least offer a different perspective on tonight. Hope you will join us.
