ATTITUDES

July 17, 2016

Most of us can easily identify bad attitudes when they are displayed outwardly in words or actions, such as negativity, criticalness, rebellion, defiance, impatience, uncooperative, apathy, discouragement, independence, my way or the highway, presumption, arrogance, self-centeredness, rudeness and such like. These are examples of bad attitudes which all Christians should reject. Such attitudes are usually seen in arrogant expressions like, "nobody is going to tell me what to do; look at me, I am my own person and I'll do it my own way" irrespective of what others want or think. In fact, the attitude seems to say, "I'll try to love you, but not so much that I would ever surrender my wants to yours! That certainly is not the agape love enjoined upon the children of God and is an attitude that without repentance will cause the soul to be lost! However, keep in mind that attitudes are inner dispositions of the heart and thoughts — they are the internal intentions which will eventually serve as the basis for our outward actions, even sinful outward actions. "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he." (Prov. 23:7). In reality, no one else really knows the thoughts of your heart, except you and God. Consequently, attitude is something that only you and God must work out — a change which must take place outwardly and inwardly, if Heaven is going to be gained.

According to scripture, our attitude toward life, our circumstances, or toward other people should always be like the Lord's — as is defined by scripture. Good attitudes are generally demonstrated in being positive, encouraging, loving, humble, teachable, cooperative, considerate, selfless, loyal, persevering, surrendering our own wants and desires for the betterment of others, and so forth (Gal. 5:22-23).

To God, our attitude should be one of reverence, submission, love, trust, humility, obedience, worship, and prayer. (Psa. 111:10, Mark 12:30, John 14:15, Jas. 4:7, 1 Sam. 15:23).

To God's children, our attitude should be filled with agape love (I'll surrender what I want and do what is best for you; forgiveness, consideration, caring, encouragement, kindness, humility, unselfishness, respectful, and impartiality (John 13:34-35, 15:12, Rom. 12:10, 13:10, 15:7, Jas. 2:9, Eph. 4:2, 4:32, Col. 3:16, 1 Thes. 5:11, Heb. 3:13, 1 Cor. 13:4-8).

To authority (elders we are instructed to obey in matters of spiritual expediency), our attitude toward them should be respectful, cooperative, accountable, humble, helpful, encouraging, loyal and not resentful, defiant, disrespectful, or arrogant (Heb. 13:7 & 17, 1 Pet. 2:13-15).

To our congregation our attitude must also be respectful, faithful, cooperative, helpful, willingness, dependable, participating, and encouraging. (1 Cor. 10:32, 1 Cor. 14:12, Heb. 2:12).

Bible love and love for the Bible will change poor attitudes to God-pleasing good attitudes through repentance and humbling ourselves in Bible love to Him and each other!
