A Note From Bryan. . . God's Will

God's will is another way of speaking of what God wants or desires. We speak of doing God's will. We pray for His will to be done. Jesus prayed that God's will be done over His own will when He prayed in the garden for "this cup to pass" Mark 14:36. One of our Wednesday night guest speakers reiterated that God's will is going to be done! I believe that Jesus' prayer in Matthew 6 is a good example for us about praying for the will of God to be done and our own desire to be reassured that God's will is being done.

Many times throughout my ministry I have noticed that there is confusion or at least a lack of agreement of what exactly constitutes God's will and how we recognize it. I have heard people comment about the fact that a loved one's life was taken because of God's will. I've even heard God be accused of taking a person's life prematurely because God needed that smile in heaven. I am not asking for you to gape at these comments and I am not asking for your agreement, I am simply presenting you with information on how individuals attribute things that happen to God's will.

Our Bibles are the only thing that we have in our possession that help us come to know God and His will. People are seeking to know God through experience and through spiritual exercises that don't involve reading God's word. In my own view, a person cannot come to know God, and, therefore, God's will apart from the Bible. While the Bible tells us many things it does not reveal everything (Deuteronomy 29:29) but it does reveal everything we need to know (2 Peter 1:3).

This morning I want to share with you three things that we can all know for sure about God's will. These are three things that are revealed in the word of God and three things that will limit our speculation. They are three things that are foundational to our faith.
