Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

A Note From Bryan... What is Jesus worth to you?

We sometimes sing #736 which asks us this same question. It really isn't an easy question to answer, and it never has been. Once a young man ran to Jesus asking Jesus what he needed to do to inherit eternal life. This young man, we are told, felt like following Jesus cost him too much, so he went away sad. How many people are lost every year because they never try? They, like the young man in the passage, go away depressed because the cost seems too high in earthly terms.

In John 12:1-8, Lazarus' sister, Mary, loved Jesus so much, she broke a bottle of expensive perfume on Jesus feet, and wiped them dry with her hair. The fragrance of her sacrifice filled the room, and, yet, her actions were questioned by those who would've used that expensive little trinket for something else, primarily for their own gain. Judas looked upon Mary's actions as foolish and costly, but, yet, wasn't Jesus worth a bottle of expensive perfume or oil?

It isn't for anyone else to decide for you what Jesus is worth to you. Only you and Jesus know what you have given up in order to follow Him. Jesus knew that it wasn't just a bottle of oil or perfume; it wasn't just a valuable product, it was the willingness it was given with, and, it was the willingness of Mary to take on the role of the lowest servant in the house when it came to Jesus. Today we are going to be looking into this passage and asking the question of what Jesus is worth to our souls.
