*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### HAVE I BECOME INDIFFERENT?

Indifference may be defined as: having no particular interest or concern; apathetic; having no marked feeling for or against; not mattering one way or the other. Indifference cannot be found in the life of a child of God if he or she would go to heaven!

Indifference is generally not found in a newborn Christian, but rather is that which insidiously creeps into one's life many times unknowingly and without intention. Nonetheless, the result is destructive to the individual and harmful to the organization of which he or she is a part. This would be true in the business world, a family, as well as the church family! A focus on indifference and its results may be more clearly understood by a study of Christ's admonition to the church at Ephesus (Revelation 2:1-7). There were good and honest people who were described as being patient, opposed to evil, and of sound doctrine. However, their motives had changed and, as a result, they were no longer doing the work which they had done in the beginning with the mind or heart of Christ. They had fallen from their first love! So it is with the Christian who has become indifferent today. At their new birth they had fully adapted to the mind of Christ, but then, over time, have allowed themselves to gradually develop an attitude of indifference toward their responsibilities to Christ and the local work. Like the Ephesians, they had left their first love! Does not Christ admonish us, as them, "Repent and do the first works or else I will come quickly and will remove your candlestick out of its place, except you repent" (Revelation 2:5)? Have we become indifferent in our love for God, the church, and the world and it's lost souls? Have we become indifferent in soul-winning; in daily Bible reading and prayer; in church attendance and Bible study; in attitude and speech and dress? Are we truly loving God and man "with a pure heart, FERVANTLY" (1 Peter 1:22) ???!

For the body to function as it should, every member of the body is to perform his or her part to the extent that they have been blessed by God with the talent to do so (1 Corinthians 12). And when one member refuses to exercise their God-given talent in support of the other members, the entire body is also caused to suffer to that degree!

We all need to be cautious and remember not to be indifferent, and if necessary, return to our first love, lest we should also become castaways (1 Corinthians 9:27). I am so excited to be with you all this morning to worship and serve God from hearts that are fervant and sincere and not indifferent!

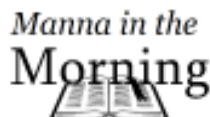
