Woodstock has just completed its 2nd annual India Missions month with the Kyle Clayton family. We enjoyed good fellowship and gained a greater appreciation of the work in India. We are partners in this great effort and our blessings are many. Kyle and family felt loved and cared for. They love Woodstock and greatly appreciate all support, communication and prayers sent their way.

Continuing our support of and commitment to the India Missions, a group of our members will again travel to India in January, 2015. Those making this trip are:

While in India this group will be presented many opportunities to teach and preach in various venues. Working alongside Kyle, Sony, Ron, and Karen Clayton, although for a very brief time, provides an opportunity to observe and experience firsthand some of the joys, frustrations, and challenges experienced by the Clayton families in this great work. Laura (nursing) and Chris (diet and nutrition) will utilize their professional expertise in the local clinics and villages. Our ladies will also present lessons at the annual Ladies Seminar in Hyderabad in mid January. The theme of the seminar is, "The Woman's Role in Maturing the Church".

We are seeking to provide all expenses for Matt and Chris and half of Dave's expenses. Expenses including VISA, immunizations, airfare, in-country expenses etc. for Matt, Chris, and Dave will be approximately \$14,000. Some of
