Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find the word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to the word of God.

FORGIVE YOURSELF

It is clear in many passages of Scripture that God does not want us to be a fault-seeking, grudge-holding, got-to-be-be-my-way kind of person. Rather He tells us to be a kind, forgiving people (Matthew 6:14-15, 18:21-35, 23:23-28, 23:34, 26:28, 27:12, 27:32, et al). It seems conclusive that most Christians are not the people God wants all to be as relates to other people, but people who find it difficult to be kind and forgiving toward self, perhaps because they perceive as some "terrible" sins in their past. What sins are these? Greater or more significant than those committed by King David? God could and did look upon David's heart and say 'He has his own heart' (1 Samuel 16:7). Though he sinned by committing the crime of murder, none can deny the penitence, piousness, humility and love of God of this great king of Israel. God never implied that David was not to sin. He was a sinner, as we are! And, as David, when we confess and repent of our sins, we can know, without doubt, that God has put away your sin; you shall not die" (2 Samuel 12:13). Our weaknesses and failures, if we develop and exhibit the qualities of this great king, we, too, as penitent sinners, no matter how many past sins, can trust God (1 John 1:9) and become and keep us to be men and women after God's own heart!

In Mark 11:25, Christ said that we are to forgive "anyone". Surely, "self" is to be included in the "anyone" of this passage. We will not forgive "anyone", including "self", He will not forgive us until we come to Him, His blood has washed it all away (Revelation 1:5) removed us from our transgressions as far as the East is from the West (Psalms 103:12) and completely forgotten them (Hebrews 8:12) write, "But one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and pressing forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13) of Paul and Christ (1 Corinthians 11:1), we must do no more but to forgive ourselves! He did!
