Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

OF IMPORTANCE TO OUR CHILDREN

Deuteronomy 6 is not simply a call to obedience for obedience' sake or obedience for happiness' sake, nor is it just a passage with principles for the home. It is a call to obedience for God's glory, as evidence of our love for God through the perpetuation of faith in the Christ from generation to generation. As God's people today (the Church of Christ), this is not unlike our call and responsibility (1 Peter. 2:5-12). Remember, these Old Testament principles, warnings, and exhortations are given for us today as examples to us and for our instruction and "that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope." (Romans 15:4).

There are three considerations that establish the background for Deuteronomy, Chapter 6, especially as relates to verse 7!

-Obedience is evidence of one's love for God.

-Warnings against disobedience in forgetting His Word.

-The need of transmitting God's truth to coming generations (II Timothy 2:2)

and more especially to our children through continual teaching and godly parenting (Ephesians 6:4b)

Deuteronomy 6 shows us how this is to be done and what is necessary if we are to be obedient people who do not forget their Lord with careful obedience to His Word in teaching others and especially our children.

The subject passage was delivered directly to Israel. But in particular, it addressed to parents—especially to fathers and grandfathers because of their leadership role according to Scripture, and because of the responsibility of both parents in the perpetuation of faith in their children.

The most important thing a father can do for self and family is to make hearing the Word of God one of the greatest priorities of his life and in the lives of his children. It is vital and critical to our ability as godly parents, and to the future of our children and that of our congregation.

We must really learn to redeem the time (Ephesians 5:16-17), even often to the point of using it much more wisely in less playing of video games and texting in favor of spending more time in God's Word by teaching our children "when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up."
