A Note From Bryan. . . Our Relationship with God

Our relationship with God is the most important relationship in our lives. Our Bibles teach us that this relationship brings so much goodness into our lives apart from our own efforts. You have probably noticed how detached and impersonal the world is becoming. Most people would rather interact electronically than physically and personally. Texting, email, and social networking are the new ways to communicate, but there is no substitute for personal interaction.

You may text your spouse several times a day or chat back and forth on Facebook, but, at some point, you have to face them one on one. Your children are the same way. Marriage and parenthood can't be done electronically. Your spouse and your children are a relationship that takes a high degree of personal investment. Other relationships, such as friends and colleagues, don't take as much time, and are free of many of the pressures of a familial relationship. While you may make many professional contacts on LinkedIn, there is no substitute for the old fashioned way of networking to find a job if you are in the market for a new position.

Our relationship with God trumps all these human interactions. If you really consider your relationship with God, it becomes clear that God is the one who brings the most to the relationship. He really doesn't need you or anything that you bring to the relationship. I know that sounds terribly harsh, but in reality, God brings everything to the relationship. He created and formed you, He redeemed you and is there for you anytime, day or night, to listen to your prayers. He has called you to Himself whether or not you heed the call. God has formed a relationship with you that only you can break because of your sin and rejection of Him.
