A Note From Bryan... A man after God's own heart

Saul was such a disappointment to God because of his constant disobedience. Because of his constant defiance, God determined to take the kingdom away from Saul and give it to a man after His own heart, 1 Samuel 13:14. David was God's choice. Soon after rejecting Saul, God sent Samuel to anoint David king over all Israel, 1 Samuel 16. If you are familiar with the rest of the story you know that it would be many years and many hardships before David assumed the throne.

This characteristic of being the man after God's own heart is really an interesting one when you consider David's life. We first learn of David as a shepherd boy tending his father's sheep. He was trusted and responsible. When he single-handedly took on the Philistine champion, Goliath, who intimidated much older, battle-hardened soldiers David, won the admiration of a grateful king and nation. David demonstrated great courage and was rewarded for that courageous action. He conquered the giant by trusting in God.

Later in his life David sinned with Bathsheba, the wife of one of his own mighty men. When confronted by the prophet Nathan, he confessed his sin and repented and received forgiveness. As he aged and his children came of age he suffered through many tragedies caused by his children. There are so many qualities of David's life that help us to understand what it means to be a man after God's own heart. Today we will look at David's Psalm 139 and look at the words of inspired poetry that tell us more about being a man after God's own heart.
