Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship, and work according to God's Holy Word.

"FAITHFUL LOVE"

The beginning of Jonah's ministry is a lot like that of Moses. Both men receive a Divine commission (Exodus 3:10/Jonah 1:2); both men object to the mission they have been given (Exodus 3:11-4:13/Jonah 1:3); both are rebuked and reassured by God (Exodus 4:14-16; Jonah 1:4-16); both men experience something supernatural that gets their attention (Exodus 4:1-5/Jonah 2:1), and both of them have to be retold what their mission will be (Exodus 4:14-16/Jonah 3:2).

In the case of Moses, when God finally gave him a task, he did not feel worthy of the assignment he had received. His countrymen did not believe in him. When God told him to go back to Egypt, Moses' faith, at that time, caused him to doubt any chance for success.

In the case of Jonah, it wasn't that he didn't feel worthy of the task so much as it was he didn't feel that those to whom he was called were worthy to receive it. Jonah had seen what the Ninevites had done to his homeland and did not think they were worth saving. By the end of the book, Jonah becomes even more agitated and angry because God saved them even though they had done so much damage to Jonah and his people.

Both of these men struggled with their faith because they allowed what they knew about people to influence their faith and what they believed about God. We too get caught in this same trap. People often disappoint us and they cause us much personal grief. However, no matter how bad the world gets, we must always remember that no one is outside of God's reach. No one will be given up on. But perhaps the greatest lesson from both of these men is that no matter how much I struggle with my faith in God, he will always be faithful to me!
