Knowing God

In John 17: 3, The Son of God said in His prayer, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent." The real thrust of this statement is that they might continue to know God. Really knowing God is an ongoing challenge of life and the greatest challenge of life! All of us have been introduced to the idea that if you want a job or a position "it's not what you know, but who you know." I believe that is an oversimplification, but certainly, in some cases, there is an element of truth to that.

In Christianity, it most certainly is a matter of what you know AND who you know! All of us realize that it is one thing to know that there is a God and it is quite another thing to really know that God! Surely we can know that there is a God by looking at the created universe. The glory of God is shown in all of its beauty (Psalm 19: 1-3)! The reality of God is written into our moral consciences. Then we turn to the revelation of God in the scriptures and know how to please him. I would ask all of us, including myself, how well do we know God? There are so many indicators that help us answer that question confidently. Consider these: daily prayer life, daily scripture study, continually acting to bring someone to Christ, not absenting ourselves from meeting together to praise God and to study His word, returning good for evil, controlling mind and tongue....the possibility of really knowing God-the GREATEST challenge of this life and as Jesus our Lord says, "And this is eternal life..." If we really know God, everything else falls into place!
