*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship, and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### A DIVIDED HOLY SPIRIT?

That the Holy Spirit is not divided and is one truth is without doubt accurate and scriptural (1 Corinthians 1:10; John 16:13; John 17:17), showing clearly that the denominational concept that teaches and practices doctrines different from the others cannot have "the (one) truth" (John 14:6; Ephesians 4:4-6). Such would be sensibly impossible! Since each denomination is markedly different, it follows logically and theoretically that only one of them could have "the (one) truth"; perhaps none of them! Jesus said, "Sanctify them through Your truth, Your Word is truth" (John 17:17)! It must then follow that only those who practice and worship according to God's Word can rightly be called His church and His people.

Many falsely claim that the Bible promotes denominationalism, because, according to them, men today cannot understand the scriptures alike! They foolishly charge God with giving us a book to read and study that we cannot understand. Paul speaks to the contrary in Ephesians 3:3, saying that when we read the mystery of Christ (the Bible) we may understand it! Jesus said in John 17:17 that God's Word is truth. In John 8:32, He said, "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Religious confusion then does not come from God or His Word (1 Corinthians 14:33). In fact, the Bible clearly condemns denominationalism (John 17:20-23; 1 Corinthians 1:10-14).

Denominations start with the presupposed doctrines and commandments of men that result in vain (empty) worship (Matthew 15:3, 6, 9). Many often attempt to force God's Word into what they want it to say. The differences and confusion in religion today comes solely from man's own desires and ideas: his own manuals; his creeds; his church laws, and so-called "Bibles" adjusted and designed to promote a particular denominational doctrine.

Only one thing can erase the differences and confusion in the religious world today and that is the rejection of the commandments of men and their doctrines while at the same time receiving with meekness the engrafted word which is able to save our souls (James 1:21); the perfect law of liberty (James 1:25). Jesus said in John 12:48 that His words will judge us in the last day! Denominational creeds will not stand in Judgment Day; nor will they who teach and follow them! It is required of all of us that in order to be saved, we must to come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Timothy 3:7)!
