A Note From Bryan... The B-i-b-l-e

The B-i-b-l-e is one of the first songs little children learn to sing in Sunday school. Incidentally it is also likely Bible is the first word they learn to spell. The Psalmist wrote so long ago, "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:105. As long as men have inhabited the earth they have been trying to find their way in this life without God's word. Many have even become enemies of God's word and seek to destroy its credibility.

Among those who attack the Scriptures in vain are those among us who claim that it is too old to be relevant to men and women living today. In their minds the events of the Bible happened too long ago and too far away to have anything useful to say to people living today. In the same way many people claim the Bible is a useless book of myths; just a bunch of fairy tales. Even among those who claim to be Christians there has emerged this thought that the Bible cannot be applied to modern men and women. There are even those who call themselves Christians who doubt the truth of the Bible.

Although it may be a revelation to some, these attacks are nothing new. There have always been those who want to destroy the word of God and make it of no effect. The easiest way to do that is to just simply ignore it, which many have done. This morning I hope to answer some of these attacks and give you reassurance of the truth of what we read in the B-i-b-l-e.
