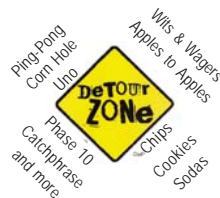


## Welcome to our Visitors

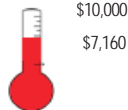

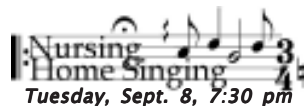

*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship, and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### OBEYING THE GOSPEL

Even though we love people mightily, the Bible is precise and clear that those who do not obey the Gospel will be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of God and the glory of His power (2 Thessalonians 1:7)! This, being true, it becomes necessary that all (1) understand what the Gospel is to which we are to be obedient and (2) that all understand the process of becoming obedient to that Gospel.

According to 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, the Gospel is the doctrine of the death, burial, and resurrection Of Christ. In Romans 6:17-18, it is clearly and lovingly stated that when one obeys from the heart a form (pattern) of that doctrine, they are then (at that point) made free from sin. In Romans 6:3-5, we take note that in baptism there is a death, a burial, and a resurrection, which is a form or pattern of the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. Therefore, the Gospel is obeyed when we reenact from the heart, the death, burial, and resurrection of our Lord in baptism. There is no other way to get "into" Christ (Romans 6:3; Galatians 3:27; 1 Peter 3:21) where God has placed salvation (2 Timothy 2:10). Those who would seek to climb some other way are said to be the same as a thief and a robber (John 10:1).

Some would say, "Well, I don't have to obey that 'form of doctrine' (be baptized); I'm really okay the way I am! After all I prayed the sinners' prayer or I accepted the Lord in my heart as my personal savior or I love God and He loves me and, therefore, 2 Thessalonians 1:7 doesn't apply to me!" Others would say, "That passage doesn't apply to me, since I was once baptized into a denominational body, after which I transferred myself out of that group into the body of Christ. Really? The Bible knows nothing about transferring out of a man-made body into the body of Christ! Only baptism from an understanding heart (obeying with knowledge of that form of the doctrine) directly into the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:13) where God has placed salvation will truly effect one's obedience and salvation. All of the saving blood (Revelation 1:5) of Christ is only "in" His body! If one really understood what it meant to obey the gospel of Jesus Christ, why would he or she be baptized into a denomination to begin with? Some say, "Well, I was baptized for the remission of sins when I was baptized into the the denominational group!" Being baptized for the remission of sins is not the only qualification necessary to understand as seen in Acts 19:1-5. In this passage they were baptized again without argument even though they were baptized for the remission of sins! They wanted to make their salvation sure! Humble folks do that! There is no saving blood of Christ in any other body through which one may pass to later gain entry and acceptance through self-proclamation, into the one body of Christ.

Lovingly, it is clear that those who refuse to obey the purpose and form of that doctrine (baptism), coupled with an understanding of the non-denominational body of Christ, will experience the punishment of 2 Thessalonians 1:7, which is the second death of Revelation 20:14-15.

Rationalization of one's relationship to Christ that dismisses and avoids simple and humble obedience to that "form of Doctrine" from an understanding heart/mind cannot save! Such rationalization is to fail!

"All" to Jesus, I surrender! Make your calling and election sure now! We love you! Do you love God?
