### Identifying the Church

A few years ago a friend of mine had his truck stolen. He had a brand new truck, but all of a sudden, it was gone! Naturally, he called the police and when they came to the scene of the theft they began to ask questions. They asked, "What kind of truck is it?" "What is the name of the truck?" Suppose my friend said, "It doesn't make any difference about the name. I love trucks, just go find me a truck of your choice." The police asked, "What model is it?" "What is the color?" Suppose he said, "It doesn't make any difference what the model is. Just go get me a truck. The color is immaterial." Suppose the police had come back with an older model truck that was just about ready to fall apart instead of his brand new truck. He would have decided that all of that information did make a difference, would he not? I suspect that if my friend had spoken to those policemen like that they would have said, "This guy is drunk or something, we better run him in!"

Yet, I could talk to many religious people about the church and say "It doesn't make any difference about the name, makes no difference when it started, makes no difference what it does, makes no difference how it worships (after all I love God and He loves me) and the religious world says I am a scholar! Does it really not matter to God? Who makes that judgment?"

Let me kindly suggest that you can find the church of the Bible, the church that Jesus built if you will look for it in just as sensible a manner as those policemen looked for my friend's car! There are identifiable marks found in the Bible. That kind of search is what will please God! It surprises a lot of people what they find!
