Your Inheritance

Your inheritance consists of much more than money. In Luke 12 Jesus encountered an individual that wanted Jesus to command their brother to divide their inheritance equitably. Jesus refused to get involved and proceeded to warn the individual against covetousness. While the idea of gaining an inheritance from a wealthy family member is attractive for most people it is a passing fantasy. Most people are going to work long hours for 40 years or more in the hopes of funding what could be a long retirement. If there is anything left that will belong to the children.

Proverbs 13:22 says, "A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, but the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous." We need to be reminded that Proverbs are not laws and are not to be interpreted as such. You are not commanded to leave a sizeable inheritance to your offspring. You are not a bad person if you are unable to leave such a large sum of money that your children can't spend it all. Warren Buffet is credited with saying that "you ought to leave enough for your children to do something but not enough to do nothing."

There are some things that you can work to acquire that last longer than money. One of the things that negatively affects inheritance money is inflation. The Bible teaches us to acquire those things that cannot be diminished by inflation. This morning I want to direct your minds in acquiring a few of those things that cannot be diminished by financial forces. When we read Proverbs 13:22 we might immediately think of money but there is more that you can leave to your children's children. There are things that you can pass from one generation to another that can bring good things into the lives of those who come after you.
