### A Note From Bryan... Touching One Life At a Time

Jesus could draw a crowd like none other. As we read through the gospels we find that most of the time there were such great crowds following Jesus that He had little time for himself. He was here for others (Mark 10:45) and not for Himself but He still needed the down time. Even though He was surrounded by such great throngs of people wanting to see miracles and be healed of diseases the gospels demonstrate how Jesus helped one person at a time.

In our zeal to reach the masses we must keep in mind that each of us is just one person with the time and ability of one person. Focus your attention on one soul at a time. To be an effective soul winner you must find one person with whom you can focus your soul winning efforts.

In Luke 7:11-16 we find that Jesus gave His gift of attention to one widow woman who had lost her son. A crowd was following Him at the time. A crowd of mourners and sympathizers was also with the widow woman but Jesus focused on her according to the text. In focusing on her He showed her compassion and restored her son to life. You can't focus on saving the world. You can't possibly show compassion to dozens of people at once. You cannot restore multiple people at once. You can, however, give the gift of attention and focus your efforts on one soul.

As you look at your own soul winning efforts find that one person who seems to be reaching out to you and following your lead and give them that attention and provide them with that spiritual leadership they need. Even though the seed multiplies you still have to plant the seed one soul at a time.
