A Note From Bryan... Questions of Faith

Kids can ask some of the most entertaining questions. They will invariably ask blunt questions about such things as a stranger's personal appearance, and they will ask at precisely the time when the stranger passes you in the grocery aisle. This is purely a hypothetical example! Children will also ask questions you are really not ready to answer, like where babies come from, etc. Although it can be trying, they really are inquisitive, because they want to know. Children are eager to learn.

Questions are vital and they serve several purposes. Some questions are asked to illicit an answer. Some questions are asked in order to challenge people to think. In the New Testament, specifically in the gospels, one finds that Jesus asked hundreds of questions, and most of the time they were the sort of questions that were probing, and were intended to make people think. After surveying the gospels and pulling out the questions Jesus asked, the list of questions was distilled to 18 of the most thought provoking questions Jesus is recorded as asking. Many of those questions are ones that you would remember from your own study.

This morning we are going to look at five questions Jesus asked about our faith. These are not questions that I can answer for you and I really wouldn't want to answer them for you. You and I must hear the questions and ponder them in our own minds. When Christ comes again will He find faith? Why do doubts plague our hearts from time to time? Do we really believe in the words of Jesus and their use in the judgment? Do you believe in the Son of God? Are you ready to surrender your life for His sake?
