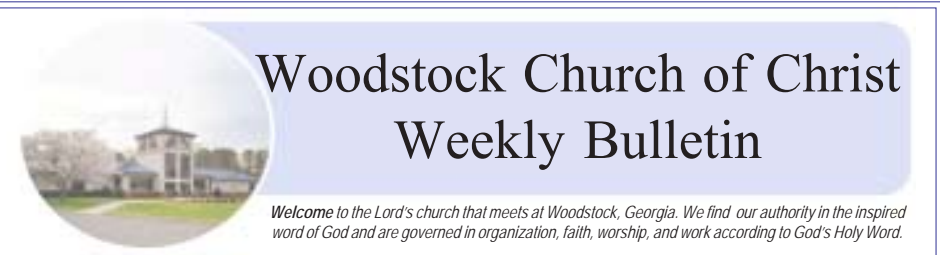

Names are used for different purposes. In our generation, many religious groups wear a name that denominates them and divides them from all other religious groups. These names separate the religious world that Christ wants united (John 17:17-20; 1 Cor. 1:10-13). But, there are names that simply denote relationship, rather than personal identity. This is the case of the name by which God's people are known and identified. When the Lord called twelve men "apostles" that name identified them in relation to Christ and the mission He designed for them. They were sent out from Him with the saving message of the gospel—thus apostles.

The name "Church of Christ" is a relational name that identifies God's people. "churches of Christ" is a biblical expression found in Romans 16:16. Paul wrote, "the churches of Christ salute you." It is not a name designed to distinguish one religious group from all others, even though, today, in many cases it does. In the first century, that was not necessary.

Various names such as "church," "the body of Christ," "the way," "the church of God," etc. all referred to the Lord's people. There were no different groups who professed to be sectarian followers of Christ. Today, that is not the case. There are numerous groups all claiming to follow the Lord's teaching but identify as human denominations.

The reason why it is appropriate today to use a scriptural name for God's people is also accommodative. If you go to a community completely strange to you and begin looking for the Lord's people, the most accommodative way for you to find them is by the name they wear. While most Christians know full well that the Lord did not give His church a name like the denominational groups use, still we need some means to identify ourselves in today's world. To refer to a local group of the people of God as the Church of Christ in that community, or to say they are members of the "West End Church of Christ" in a certain city is such an accommodation. It is not an effort to denominationalize the church.

A preacher once said, "you can have the right name of the wrong church but you can't have the right church without the right name." I still find that pretty good logic and am not of the disposition to dispute it. The name is important. If you are in a religious group that does not show by its name that it is related to Christ, it is time, (for this reason and others) to exit from it and find the Lord's people—those who are named by Him and called after Him (Acts 4:12; Romans 16:16)!
