A Note From Bryan... Meeting Introduction

We don't come into this world with a long list of measurable and usable skills. We are not born knowing how to treat our spouses; we are not born with those skills and most households are not equipped with a sufficient supply of those skills to be able to pass them on. We do not possess innate skills, often, for handling ourselves well when we are under pressure. You were not born with a natural knack for equitably settling your personal disputes in order to promote unity in a group. You must work hard at all these plus working at managing consequences and learning to forgive. You have to learn to work at building a balanced spiritual life.

My aim for this meeting is to lay the groundwork that will help you begin to put these pieces together into a balanced framework for every aspect of your life. What we were born with is a natural desire to fulfill our wants and seek to fulfill ourselves. It is natural to want but we often get what we don't want as a result. The Holy Spirit gave the words directly from God's mouth and I would encourage you to read James 4:1-4. This speaks of what experts call human need theory. What we want doesn't occur naturally and it will not drop into your lap. You will have to work at it and realize that the only way for you to get your way is for you to bend your will to God's! None of this stuff we want that is achievable has to do with money or things and all these things have the ability to bring happiness and fulfillment into our lives.

 3. You want friends and harmony in the church.
 4. You want forgiveness (give and receive) as well as to be able to manage consequences.
 5. You want a better, closer walk with Jesus.
- We can have all these things but it will take your best efforts.
