Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

LEAVENED OR UNLEAVENED?

Leaven is described as "an element, influence, or agent that works subtly to lighten, enliven, or modify a whole". Jesus spoke of the influence of leaven in Luke 13:21 when He said, "the kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened." The thrust of the passage is seen in the giving of the Great Commission in that His followers are to influence "all the world" through the proclamation of the Gospel. This type of influence may be classified as good and that which God enjoins upon all of His people. In Matthew 5:14, Christ, in referring to the influence of Christians says, "you are the light of the world" and that we are, therefore, to let our light "so" shine, or to allow our influence to shine, through good works, to glorify the Father. One's light (influence) may "so" shine or one's light (influence) may not "so" shine, but will sometimes shine in a way that does not glorify God. That the Pharisees and Sadducees had such influence cannot be denied, of which Jesus said, "Beware of the influence of their doctrine". Clearly, then, influence of some sort is always present. It will either produce that which is good to God's glory or that which is not good to the glory of the "prince of the world" (John 12:31).

In Galatians 5:9, we note that "A little leaven leavens the whole lump", thus, the scriptural demand for only godly leaven, or influence, by those within the body of Christ. That leaven of a baser sort is not permitted among the members of the body of Christ is made clear by Paul when he writes in I Corinthians 5:7, "Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us".

May we always be encouraged to be aware of how our influence reflects on each other, on the church collectively, and most especially on our God.
