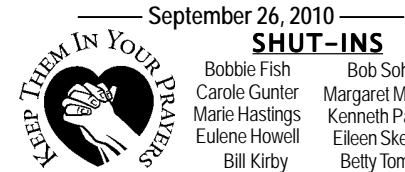

### A Note From Bryan. . . Inspiration

Inspiration is a subject that every Christian ought to have firmly in their minds. The divine inspiration of the Scriptures is one of those basic things or first principles every young Christian needs to grasp early in order to grow spiritually. Understanding inspiration helps us to understand the "why" of obedience. If the words on the page are authentically God's then they carry God's authority and we must obey them.

Understanding inspiration is important for another reason. There are so many today seeking to destroy the credibility and authenticity of the Bible message. From the historical programs on television to the conversations that you have with your unbelieving neighbors there is so much misinformation about the Bible floating around out in the world you need to be armed with truth. It has been said that a lie told a thousand times is easier to believe than a word of truth no one has ever heard. In the world we live in I believe the intent is to marginalize the truth of God's word to the point that its truths are rarely heard so that men's lies can be perpetuated.

The various terms of inspiration that are being thrown around today in casual conversation are a different sort of inspiration. People are seeking a natural sort of inspiration where they are moved by stories, quotes, and new information. The Bible claims to be the words directly from the mouth of God fully revealed to man through the agency of the Holy Spirit. Scholars refer to this as the plenary verbal inspiration of the Scriptures. This is the form of inspiration that will be the subject of today's lesson so that you are fully prepared to wear the armor of God and fend off the fiery darts of the evil one.
