*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### CAN YOU BELIEVE IT?

#### Before 1523 AD:

Jesus said: "He who believes and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16).  
 Peter said: (1) "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Christ for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38). (2) "Baptism doth also now save us" (1 Peter 3:21).  
 Ananias said: "Arise and be baptized, washing away your sins" (Acts 22:16).  
 Paul said: "Baptism is that which puts one into Christ". (Romans 6:3 & Galatians 3:27).  
 Justin Martyr (100-165 AD) wrote, "Then they are brought to us where there is water, and are regenerated . . . They then receive the washing with the water." After quoting John 3:5, he says, "we have learned from the apostles this reason 'for baptism', in order that we . . . may obtain in the water the remission of sins."  
 Tertullian (145-220 AD) wrote, "Happy is our sacrament of water, in that, by washing away of the sins of our early blindness, we are set free and admitted into eternal life."  
 Cyril (315-386 AD) wrote, "Great is the baptism that lies before you: a ransom to captives; a remission of offenses; a death of sin; a new birth of the soul."  
 Augustine (354-430), wrote, "The salvation of man is effected in baptism;" We are "joined to Christ by baptism;" and "without baptism . . . it is impossible for any man to attain salvation and everlasting life."

#### After 1523 AD:

Then, coming through a time during which the men listed above; in the New Testament and all other "church fathers" agreed and practiced the truth of baptism "for the remission of sins," Ulrich Zwingli came along after fifteen centuries had passed, in 1523 AD, and concluded that all of the above were wrong, that they, according to his very words, "have been in error from the time of the apostles," and he alone, based on his own intellect and "feeling in his heart," has now discovered the truth; that all others were wrong; and that all of them were teaching error! He dismissed and rejected the belief and practice of baptism for the remission of sins as held by all previously for fifteen hundred years! After 1523 AD Zwingli's newly developed, unsound theory was adopted and promoted by John Calvin throughout the many denominations and has been kept alive by Billy Sunday, Billy Graham, Jerry Falwell, Charles Stanley, and others who now proudly proclaim that salvation results solely from reciting a "Sinner's Prayer" or "accepting Jesus into one's heart as his personal savior," phrases and a doctrine that cannot be found in the New Testament!
