The Devil is Sly!

People have a certain attitude toward the end of something. The end is something to use as one pleases, to give to another, or just throw away. Many times when one comes to the end of something, he feels an independency connected with it that normally is not the case when considering the "main part." In the area of food we call this end or least significant part the "leftovers." A lot of times what is done with things that are leftover in many areas? Yes, they are given away, or thrown away, or whatever! You get the point- that which is "leftover" is not seen as important as the main part!

Do we not play into Satan's hands when we begin to think that Sunday is part of the "weekend?" The general attitude is that I've worked hard all week and a little bit of it remains, therefore it is my time and I'll use it as I please! We refer to this section of time as the "weekend." But that terminology is wrong at least as it applies to Sunday, the **FIRST day of the week, the LORD'S DAY!** The week's beginning needs to be used as the Lord intended, in worship! The holidays that are being observed in America are often referred to as the weekend that includes Friday afternoon through Sunday evening. "Long weekends" even include the second day of the week, Monday! Weird thinking, isn't it? The devil is sly isn't he? He hits the Lord's Day by duping people into thinking it is the weekend when we play, rest, and view it as our time! Satan goes a step further with some religious people who think that Sunday is a day of rest, even in some circles Sunday is called "the Christian Sabbath!" The word Sabbath means rest. So Sunday, the Christian Sabbath so-called, is a day of rest! Are you kidding? Can't wait to see the biblical passage for that one!

Beloved, we have fallen into thinking the weekend is mine! Well, so be it - let the true weekend, Friday evening and Saturday, be used for some relaxation, entertainment, and change of pace. The Lord knows we need it! But please don't misunderstand, no matter what the world thinks! Sunday is not the weekend! It is different! It has been separated to the Lord for worship it is His day (Rev. 1:10)! It is not being suggested that no rest or enjoyment can be had on Sunday, but it is being suggested that these things **must not** interfere with the appointments God has given to us on His day, the first day of the week (not the weekend) to worship (Acts 20:7; Heb. 10:25)!

Does the "weekend" so-called come at the expense of your meeting with Christians to study the Bible at 9:30, or worshipping at 10:30 and 6:00? By the way the attendance record looks at 9:30 and 6:00, it appears that some have bought into Satan's trickery and think Sunday is the "weekend" and not the Lord's Day, the first day of the week. The devil is sly, isn't he?
