A Note From Bryan. . . The Life of Christ

Whole classes are taught in Sunday school, Preacher Training School, and Bible Colleges on the life Jesus lived on this earth. Jesus' life was interesting. There are things we know that capture our imagination. There are things we'd like to know more about. Most people are at least mildly curious about Jesus' looks, his height, and size. Throughout the 20th and 21st centuries His austerity has been something of a novelty for most of us as well.

Jesus was clear about the fact that He did not have all the earthly entrapments that we long for and cling to. He pointed out that animals like foxes and birds had shelter but He didn't own a home of His own and yet Jesus was not a homeless derelict. Jesus told people not to worry about clothes and having many changes of clothes yet the soldiers who assisted with the crucifixion gambled for Jesus' clothes and one of his garments was of such quality that no one wanted to ruin it by cutting it in pieces.

Before I digress any further, I'll get to the point of today's lesson: we rightly look at all the great qualities of Jesus in order to imitate them in our own lives yet the reason those qualities are highlighted by the Scriptures is to show us Jesus' focus in life. If we step away from the trees to glimpse at the forest, what we find is that all the great qualities that we admire and seek to emulate contributed to a life solely focused on the life to come rather than this present, temporary existence.

Jesus life was completely focused on the Father and obedience to the Father's will and completing the work of the Father in Heaven. Jesus was in the here and now of His time but accomplishing only those things that contributed to the life to come. Jesus focused on eternity rather than on the earthly. So often we get caught up focusing on the here and now of our every day existence. We get focused on temporal success, stress at work, raising our children, financial security and a host of other things that cause us to forget that there is an eternal reward waiting for the obedient and it is of much greater scope and depth than any of the temporal things upon which we tend to focus. The overall message of Jesus life was to focus on treasure in heaven and live today for the eternity of tomorrow.
