In God We Trust

Ancient, Godly wisdom tells us to "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." These are the words of the wise man in Proverbs 3:5, 6. Modern scholars concur that trust is the most important aspect of any relationship. The people with whom we keep close company are those we trust the most. When trust is breeched or damaged it is difficult to repair. Has your trust been damaged by anything lately? Lately, we have had one demonstration after another of damaged trust. The past two weeks have shown us that we really can't fully trust our elected officials, our government as a whole. We have had it demonstrated that we cannot trust those who sit in high places on Wall Street, our bankers, lawyers. We can't seem to trust money or markets or even our employment. We just can't put all our trust into these things. However, there is one place we can put all our trust and should and that is in the Almighty God who sits on High and who knows, sees, and is in control of all things.

- Colossians 1:17 "And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist."

It is always important to remember that God can always be trusted and that our lives need to reflect that trust but now in this season of uncertainty one thing remains certain. God is in control and we can completely trust Him to bring us through no matter what occurs. The past few weeks have caused us to speculate what might happen and I can only guess the level of anxiety it has caused in your life. What we need to focus our energies on is trusting in God.
