### LAYING UP TREASURE (NO.2)

Laying up treasures in Heaven is not a hit and miss effort! It is being faithful in that effort even until death (Revelation 2:1b). Being faithful means every day, one day at a time, "forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead and pressing toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13-14). Not only must we forget those things which are behind, but we must not worry about the physical things for tomorrow (Matthew 6:34), but focus mightily in faithfulness during the day at hand.

We often think of earthly treasures in terms of money, bank accounts, houses, cars, etc. Indeed such "things" may be classified as treasure, but we need to also recognize as earthly treasures those things that are intangible. For example, Ananias and Sapphira wanted to store up the earthly treasure of having others think highly about them while clinging to their property's value which they partially held back. They desired praise and money more than obediently honoring the God they hypocritically claimed to serve. The same is true of the rich ruler in Luke 18:18ff who wanted eternal life, but not to the point of giving up what he had laid up for himself, and so he went away sorrowful. Had he responded positively to the Savior's directive, he would have laid up treasure that would have been reserved for him in Heaven!

On the other side of the coin, we must also consider that our Lord does not forbid His followers from "having things", but what He does forbid is that we possess an intangible, treasured attitude that focuses on the physical over and above the spiritual; that we would do anything to gain and retain that "thing" we covet most. "Things" are not intrinsically evil, but when we ascribe excessive personal value to them they then become our treasure. How is one richly blessed by God with wealth to lay up treasures in heaven? "Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life" (1 Timothy 6:16-17).
