WHAT IS HATE SPEECH?

Hate speech is a term for speech intended to degrade a person or group of people based on their race, gender, age, ethnicity, nationality, religion, disability, language ability, ideology, social class, occupation, appearance, mental capacity, and any other distinction that might be considered by some as a liability.

However, often, in an attempt to manipulate and control personal or group goals and purposes, some will suggest that something preached or taught is "hate speech" when in reality there is no intent or hint of such. For example, a person in presenting the truth of God's Word may condemn certain activities or practices that according to the Bible are sinful; things such as abortion, same sex marriage, homosexuality, etc. Simply because a person stands in support of others who may promote such sinfulness, they are not, thereby, given the right under any circumstance to scream "hate speech" in an attempt to silence the preaching of truth thereby providing cover for those whom they support. I take note that our Lord condemned the sins taught and practiced by the Pharisees, and then very forcefully identified them publicly as fools, hypocrites, blind guides, serpents, and a generation of vipers! Hate speech? I think not! He clearly identified the sinners and the source of these sins in order that His followers might be warned lest they too be affected and found guilty of the same. In citing the sin and the source of the sin, Jesus was not engaging in "hate speech" as some would suggest today. He preached and taught in love for all men and the Father, even to the point of death.

Brethren, the proclamation of truth and the public identification of sin and its source is demanded of those who would follow the example of Christ as we are commanded to do (I Corinthians 11:1). To cover a sin by wrongly proclaiming "hate speech" is to aid and abet the sinner and to bid him God speed (II John 9-11)! Those who do so will not be found guiltless.
