### A Note From Bryan. . . Life in Christ

You are a free, moral agent. You have so many choices about how you live your life. You can allow your life to be consumed by immorality and idolatry. You have the freedom to go out and get all that life has to offer and experience everything your heart desires. Does that mean that you should? Does that mean that if you make a different choice, like restraint, that you are missing something in life? My father made his first trip to Pakistan in 1995 and his first layover was in the city of Bangkok, Thailand. Upon entering the cab to his hotel, the driver promptly issued a laundry list of places to go and experiences common for the westerner which cannot be mentioned in this article. When he refused all of them, simply wanting to go directly to his hotel, the cab driver told him he was dead; he had no life since he didn't want to go and practice evil and immorality.

When you choose to live life in Christ you have chosen a life of restraint, a life of good, moral decisions that will result in a better quality of life. Becoming a Christian and choosing restraint does not mean that your skin is going to miraculously become clearer and younger looking. It does not mean that you are going to be wealthy or that your health is going to improve exponentially. As a matter of fact, we are going to look at several verses from God's word where Jesus said people are going to observe your good behavior and they are going to hate you because your restraint shines a light upon their darkness.

In today's lesson we are going to closely examine a few of the qualities of life in Christ and why life in Christ is a better quality of life. If you don't have that quality of life as we begin this discussion, an opportunity will be given at the end of the discussion for you to change that and choose the restraint that comes from the Christian life. No one will ever promise you that being a Christian is easy, but they will assure you that being a Christian is better!
