LAYING UP TREASURE (NO.3)

Today it is the tendency to measure a person's worth and value by the things he possesses. We count those most successful who have the largest bank account, the biggest house, and the nicest limousine. But having a greater abundance of "things" does not equate to the promised abundant life, but rather often endangers the eternity of the soul in Heaven. "And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content, but those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and *into* many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition" (1 Timothy 6:6&8). Without having salvation and the assurance of life eternal through Christ our Lord, we will have absolutely nothing when all is said and done since all material things will have been dissolved with fervent heat (2 Peter 3:10-11). Certainly, "we brought nothing into *this* world, *and it is* certain we can carry nothing out" (1 Timothy 6:7).

Every soul we teach will be a treasure laid up in heaven. Every prayerful thanksgiving to God, every precious thought of Him is treasure laid up in heaven. Every sacrificial act motivated by love for man and Christ is an addition to our treasure store in heaven. Every gathering together before Him in spirit and truth is a treasure in heaven. Every act of scriptural worship before God is treasure in heaven. Whatever pure thought or kind word, or loving deed, or song, or presented truth makes us to be a little more like our Lord, is a treasure laid up in heaven. With our treasure held in reserve we can rest with the peace and knowledge that "we know whom we have believed and are persuaded that He is able to keep what we have committed to Him until that Day" (2 Timothy 1:12b).
